Our goal at Camp Mokule'ia is to engage campers in a safe, Christian community to help them create cherished life long memories. We are located on 30 beautiful acres of Hawaiian beachfront property where we strive to care and share the land we have been blessed with.

Camp Mokule`ia's Mission and Vision:

Camp Mokule`ia, a historically sacred place of rest, recreation and renewal, is a ministry of the Episcopal Church in Hawai'i that inspires individuals and communities to connect with the goodness and blessings of all God's Creation. Camp Mokule`ia, upholding Christian and Hawaiian values, is dedicated to maintain, develop, sustain and care for its natural resources, offer a safe gathering place for all who enter, and provide for Christian ministry through intentional service to spiritual needs of the Episcopal diocese and the community.

Your **responsibilities** as a Counselor In Training will include but not be limited to the following:

- Attend Staff Training June 7 - 17, 2023
- Ability to work 4 weeks of residential camp
 - June 18 - 23: Session 1
 - June 25 - 30: Session 2 (one week break in between session 2 & 3)
 - July 9-14: Session 3
 - July 16-21: Session 4
- Live in the cabin with campers and other counselors during camp sessions
- Follow policies and procedures set forth in your staff manual relating to safety and human relations
- Ensure the health and safety of campers and report issues to staff as necessary

- Effectively assist in managing cabin and activity groups emphasizing cooperation, support, and problem solving with the help of Camp Counselors
- Assist campers in setting tables for mealtimes
- Take photos throughout the day to be posted for families to see
- Assist in running the snack shack (taking snack orders, recording amounts spent)
- Be a positive Christian role model and help campers develop their Christian faith
- Assist in leading multiple activities such as paddleboarding, kayak/canoeing, swimming, low ropes activities, nature hikes, field games
- Ability to value and respect the opinions and beliefs of others
- Design and implement a campwide summer-long service project with other CITs

Qualifications:

- Must be a Hawaii resident
- Must have completed 11th or 12th grade by the start of summer 2023
- Uphold the Christian mission and vision of Camp Mokule'ia
- Must be fully vaccinated against Covid-19

Benefits:

\$1,000 for the full summer over the course of the summer camp period, meals and housing are provided. Laundry is also available on site.
