



Camp Mokule'ia Summer Camp Counselor Job Description:

Are you looking for a fun and meaningful summer position where you can facilitate waterfront activities, team-building, and games while sharing your Christian faith with campers of all ages? If so, we hope you'll apply to join our 2023 Summer Staff here at Camp Mokule'ia! Our goal is to engage campers in a safe, Christian community to help them create cherished life long memories. We are located on 30 beautiful acres of Hawaiian beachfront property where we strive to care for and share the land we have been blessed with.

Camp Mokule'ia's Mission and Vision:

Camp Mokule'ia, a historically sacred place of rest, recreation and renewal, is a ministry of the Episcopal Church in Hawai'i that inspires individuals and communities to connect with the goodness and blessings of all God's Creation. Camp Mokule'ia, upholding Christian and Hawaiian values, is dedicated to maintain, develop, sustain and care for its natural resources, offer a safe gathering place for all who enter, and provide for Christian ministry through intentional service to spiritual needs of the Episcopal diocese and the community.

Your **responsibilities** as a camp counselor will include but not be limited to the following:

- Attend Staff Training June 7 - 17, 2023
- Ability to work six weeks of residential camp
 - June 18 - 23: Session 1
 - June 25 - 30: Session 2
 - July 5 - 7: Camp for young adults with special needs
 - July 9-14: Session 3
 - July 16-21: Session 4
 - July 23-28: Day Camp / Adventure Camp / or Camp Anuenue
- Work 1 shift on a weekend throughout the summer assisting with oceanfront activities, low element team building activities, or
- Live in cabin with campers during each camp session, live in cabin with other counselors on weekends

- Follow the policies and procedures set forth in your staff manual relating to safety and human relations
- Ensure the health and safety of campers and report issues to staff as necessary
- Effectively manage cabin and activity groups emphasizing cooperation, support, and problem solving
- Be a positive Christian role model and help campers develop their Christian faith
- Lead multiple activities such as paddleboarding, kayaking, swimming, low element team building activities, nature hikes, field games, campfires, etc.
- Ability to value and respect the opinions and beliefs of others
- Be willing to fill in as needed if camper numbers are low. Possible other responsibilities include but are not limited to lifeguarding, assisting with ocean activities or the challenge course/zipline, chaplaincy, assisting in other departments such as property management or housekeeping.

Qualifications:

- Must be 18 years of age and be one full year out of high school by the start of summer 2023
- Be willing to be CPR/AED, First Aid, and/or Lifeguard certified (will be provided during staff training)
- Uphold the Christian mission and vision of Camp Mokule'ia
- Must be fully vaccinated against Covid-19

Benefits:

\$2,000 for the full summer paid out bi-weekly (June 7th-July 29th), reimbursement for up to \$500 for travel expenses, food and housing, laundry available on site
