



CAMP MOKULE'IA COVID POLICY

March 8, 2022

First and foremost, the safety and well-being of our guests and staff is our top priority. Throughout the pandemic, we have attempted to set COVID protocols based on guidelines of the City and County of Honolulu, the State of Hawaii, the Episcopal Diocese of Hawaii, and the recommendations of the CDC. Therefore, we are adjusting our guidelines to be in line with new City and County policies.

COVID Policies for Retreat and Campground Guests

Effective immediately, Camp Mokule'ia will no longer require guests to provide proof of vaccination or a negative COVID test when coming on the grounds. However, due to the nature of shared living spaces at camp we recommend that group leaders still encourage members of their group to be vaccinated or have a negative COVID test.

Masks are still required indoors and we ask that masks still be worn in outdoor common areas (going to the restrooms, Dining Hall lanai, etc.). Social distancing is recommended.

COVID Policies for Summer Camp Camper

Camp Mokule'ia is still requiring all Summer Camp campers to be vaccinated or have a negative COVID test within 72 hours of arrival at camp. As we are a residential facility and have guests/staff from around the state and the mainland, we are trying to mitigate the risk of spreading COVID. We would like to take this small extra precaution to uphold the safety and well-being of our campers and staff. Mahalo for helping us ensure the success of a wonderful Summer Camp season.
