- Learn to lead multiple activities such team builders, ice breakers, discussion breakout groups, and games
- Ability to value and respect the opinions and beliefs of others

- Must **currently** live in Hawaii
- Must currently be in 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade
- Uphold the Christian mission and vision of Camp Mokuē'ia
- Must be fully vaccinated against Covid-19

**Compensation:**

- Stipend for the duration of the program paid at the end of the program
- Meals and lodging during the retreat weekends
- Airport shuttle from and to the airport for those coming from neighboring islands
