



2024 Camp Mokulē'ia Summer Camp Counselor Job Description:

Are you looking for a fun and meaningful summer position where you can facilitate waterfront activities, team-building, and games while sharing your Christian faith with campers of all ages? If so, we hope you'll apply to join our 2024 Summer Staff here at Camp Mokulē'ia! Our goal is to engage campers in a safe, Christian community to help them create cherished life long memories. We are located on 30 beautiful acres of Hawaiian beachfront property where we strive to care for and share the land we have been blessed with.

Camp Mokulē'ia's Mission and Vision:

Camp Mokulē'ia, a historically sacred place of rest, recreation and renewal, is a ministry of the Episcopal Church in Hawai'i that inspires individuals and communities to connect with the goodness and blessings of all God's Creation. Camp Mokulē'ia, upholding Christian and Hawaiian values, is dedicated to maintain, develop, sustain and care for its natural resources, offer a safe gathering place for all who enter, and provide for Christian ministry through intentional service to spiritual needs of the Episcopal diocese and the community.

Qualifications:

- **Must be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 before June 7, 2024**
- Must be a United States resident. We are unable to accept international applicants at this time.
- Ability to attend Staff Training June 3 - 15, 2024
- Ability to work six weeks of residential camp
 - June 16 - 21 Session 1
 - June 23 - 28 Session 2
 - July 1 - 4 Camp Ho`omana (for young adults with special needs)
 - July 7 - 12 Session 3
 - July 14 - 19 Session 4
 - July 21 - 26 Session 5 - The assistant director will divide the staff into small groups to help run camps at different locations.
 - Day Camp with the Episcopal Church of West Kauai
 - Day Camp with Holy Apostles Church on the Big Island
 - Adventure Camp at Camp Mokulē'ia
 - Camp Anuenue at Camp Mokulē'ia
 - VBS with Kailua United Methodist Church on O'ahu
- Must have the ability to provide fun and creative activities to youth
- Must be 18 years of age and one full year out of high school by June 2024
- CPR/AED and First Aid certified OR Lifeguard certified (certification trainings will be provided during staff training)

- Uphold the Christian mission and vision of Camp Mokulē'ia

Your **responsibilities** as a camp counselor will include but not be limited to the following:

- Ensure the health and safety of campers. Report issues to leadership staff.
- Be a positive Christian role model and help campers develop their Christian faith
- Effectively manage cabin/activity groups emphasizing cooperation, support, and problem solving.
- Ability to value and respect the opinions and beliefs of others.
- Lead multiple activities such as paddleboarding, kayaking, swimming, low element team building activities, nature hikes, field games, campfires, etc.
- Work 1 shift on a weekend throughout the summer assisting with programming.
- Live in a cabin with campers during each camp session.
- Live in a cabin with other summer staff on weekends.
- Follow the policies/procedures in your staff manual relating to safety and human relations.
- Be willing to fill in as needed if registration numbers are low. Possible other responsibilities include but are not limited to lifeguarding, assisting with ocean activities or the challenge course/zipline, chaplaincy, and in other departments such as property management or housekeeping.

Benefits:

\$2,000 for the full summer paid out bi-weekly (June 3th - July 28th), reimbursement for up to \$500 for travel expenses (if living off island), food and housing, laundry available on site.
